

Mesa Arts Center to offer Arts Activities for Adults with Dementia and their Caregivers

**MESA, AZ** – Through funding from a national grant received from *Creativity Connects*, Mesa Arts Center and Banner Alzheimer's Institute have developed Arts in Mind, a program that creates arts experiences for individuals with mild to moderate dementia and their caregivers. An expansion of Mesa Art Center's Creative Aging Program, Arts in Mind offers arts engagements such as hands-on art making, museum experiences and concert events.

"The program will offer opportunities for those affected by dementia and Alzheimer's to cultivate dignity and enrich their sense of self, while building connections between themselves and loved ones through fun and expressive arts engagements." – Mandy Tripoli, Director of Engagement at Mesa Arts Center

Research suggests that engagement in arts-based activities for older adults contributes to quality of life, increased community interaction and building companionship.
