

Ana Bárbara was born on Jan. 10, 1971 in Rio Verde, SLP. In 1994, she released her first album, Ana Bárbara, and was quickly crowned the queen of Grupero, currently publishing more than 10 studio albums. Bárbara has written more than 60 songs, among which stand out: "lo busque," "fruta prohibida" and "quisiera olvidarte" and has sold several million copies of her records. Ana is one of the few singer-songwriters to achieve international public recognition. In addition to Mexico and the United States, she has thousands of fans in all Latin American countries. During more than 20 years of her career, she has excelled in different musical genres, from mariachi to pop, a Sinaloan band, grupero and romantic ballads with millions of sold records. Her latest hit "solos" has exceeded 27 million views.
