Adult Art Studio classes include a variety of mediums, such as glass, ceramics, welding, jewelry, weaving, dance, printmaking, drawing, photography and more. workshops, **Coldworking: Facet the World** with Sergio Vettori and **Flameworking: Details and Textures** with Austin Hensley.

Youth and Teen Art Studio classes and camps include jewelry, photography, animation, ceramics, printmaking, glass and more. Youth and Teen Summer Camps vary weekly and will keep kids engaged and inspired all summer long. Camp highlights include **Creation Craze**, a colorful multimedia class for ages 6–10; **Desert Designs with Fabric**, where our desert home inspires textile masterpieces like quilting, embroidery and painting on canvas for ages 7–11; **Everyone is an Architect**, where students will learn about the industrious world of architectural design and city planning for ages 11–15; and **Glass Sampler for Teens**, an introduction to a variety of art glass techniques for teens 13+.
