Adult programming has been expanded, adding additional movement, theater and photography classes. Finally, Mesa Arts Center is thrilled to welcome the return of youth programming.

Arts in Service classes are free for veterans and service members. Fall class offerings include Yoga, Glass, Jewelry, Welding, Ceramics, Printmaking and Blacksmithing. All classes are appropriate for beginners and do not require any previous arts experience. All materials are included with registration. Arts in Service is in its 4th year and is sponsored by The Boeing Company and Salt River Pima Maricopa Indian Community. Arts in Service is also funded in part by the Arizona Department of Veterans' Services as made available through the Arizona Veterans' Donation Fund.

Adult Art Studio Workshop offerings include Beginning–Intermediate Lapidary: Creating Cabochons, Beginning Silkscreen, Beginning–Advanced Blacksmithing, Unusual Shape Greeting Cards, Holiday Card Making, Build Your Own Gas Forge Workshop, Unusual Shape Boxes and a Photographing Your Artwork workshop.

Adult Art Studio Classes include classes and workshops in a variety of mediums, including movement, theater, ceramics, metal sculpture, welding, blacksmithing, jewelry, glass, painting, drawing, photography and printmaking. Classes are available at all skill levels, with many beginning classes that do not require any arts experience.

Youth Art Studio Class offerings include Drawing and Painting, Youth Stage Acting, Script Writing for Teens, Youth Improv Basics, Teen Wheel Throwing, Fusing: Tacky Characters, Teen Printmaking, Youth Stage Acting, Creating Character and Scene Study!
